RULES

ARTICLE 1. Organization

The 79th Giro dell'Appennino is organized by Unione Sportiva Pontedecimo cycling AD based in via G. Poli 28R 16164 Genova, email: segreteria@uspontedecimo.it, in accordance with the International Cycling Union regulations. The event manager is Silvano Parodi tel. +393394631087 living in Genoa, Via Natale Gallino 17C / 7.

The race will take place on April 22nd, 2018.

ARTICLE 2. Type of race

The 79th Giro dell'Appennino is reserved to riders belonging to the Men Élite Category and is recorded in the UCI Europe Tour calendar.

The race is class 1.1. In compliance with article 2.10.008 of the UCI Regulations, the points to be attributed for the individual Continental Elite Men ranking are as follows 125, 85, 70, 60, 50, 40, 35, 30, 25, 20, 15, 10, 5, 5, 5, 3, 3, 3, 3, 3, 3, 3, 3, 3, 3. The event is the second race of the "1st Challenge Liguria".

ARTICLE 3. Participation

In compliance with the provisions of article 2.1.005 of the UCI Regulations, the race is reserved to UCI Pro Teams (max. 50%), to UCI Professional Continental Teams, to UCI Continental Teams and National Teams.

In compliance with the provisions of article 2.2.003 of the UCI Regulations, each team shall be composed of a minimum of 5 to a maximum of 7 riders.

ARTICLE 4. License Control, confirmation of the departing riders and collection of race numbers

License control will take place on April 21st from 3.30 pm to 4.45 pm at the accounting offices of Centro Poliambulatoriale "Casa della Salute" – Busalla (GE), Largo Milite Ignoto, 6.

The confirmation of the departing riders, as well as the collection of race numbers will take place from 3.30 pm to 4.45 pm.

The meeting of the Team Managers with the Commissaries Panel, organized according to the provisions of article 1.2.087 of the UCI Regulations, will take place at 5.00 pm, at Punto d'incontro Coop – Busalla (GE), Largo Milite Ignoto, 4.

ARTICLE 5. Radio Information

Race news are broadcasted by the Italian Cycling Federation staff (F.C.I.) on its own frequencies (Mhz 149,850).

ARTICLE 6 – Technical Assistance

The technical assistance service is ensured by SCOTT - SMP with 3 servicing cars.

ARTICLE 7 – Prizes

The total amount of prizes of the final classification is Euro 14,520.00 and it will be divided as per F.C.I. - League of the Professional Cycling – tables, prizes for race class 1.1.

ARTICLE 8. Mountain Sprint

The prize of the Mountain sprint is calculated on the following 7 mountain passes considered for this ranking (Passo della Castagnola, Passo dei Giovi, Crocetta d'Orero, Passo dei Giovi, Passo della Bocchetta, Fraconalto, Passo dei Giovi).

Each pass gives 3, 2, 1 points to the first 3 riders.

The general ranking is established by adding the points won on all the 7 passes above mentioned. To be entitled to the prizes, the riders have to finish the race. In case of equality the best position at the arrival will be decisive.

The prizes of the Mountain sprint are as follows:

ARTICLE 9 – Feed zone

The feed zone is in compliance with articles 2.3.025 / 026 / 027 UCI. The fixed feed zone is indicated with relevant symbols in the race profile and time schedule and will be signposted along the race route. Moreover the organisation will set up a so-called “Green area”, with dedicated personnel, located before and after the fixed feed zone, stretching over 200m.

ARTICLE 10. Car deviation

The deviation of all the cars in the race convoy is required, with the exception of the cars of the Race Director, the Commissaires, the doctor and that of the team manager whose rider, alone, has an advantage of at least 1 '(one minute).

ARTICLE 11. Maximum time

In compliance with the provisions of article 2.3.039 of the UCI Regulations, riders with a gap higher than 8% of the winner's time will be considered as out of time limit. The delay may be increased, under special circumstances, by the Commissaires Panel in accordance with the Organization.

ARTICLE 12. Anti-doping Control

The UCI anti-doping regulation and the Italian law provisions apply to the Anti-doping Control, which will be made at PalaGym Assarotti, via S.Bartolomeo degli Armeni 1, Genova.

ARTICLE 13. Awards

In compliance with the provisions of article 1.2.112 of the UCI Regulations, the first three riders arrived, the first rider at Passo della Bocchetta, the winner of the Mountain Sprint place list, the first Under26 and the winner of the Challenge Liguria shall attend the awards ceremony.

ARTICLE 14. Sanctions

All breaches shall be sanctioned according to the UCI Regulations, and to the respective “sanction chart”, art. 12.1.040.

ARTICLE 15. General Provisions

Only persons identified upon collection of the identification badge of the authorized vehicle are entitled to follow the race. Possible changes or additions shall be notified to the Organization Director. Drivers of cars and motorbikes with regular accreditation shall comply with the provisions set forth by the Rules of the Road and shall furthermore comply with the rules set out by the Organization Director and his Officials. Persons who are not recognized as having roles acknowledged by the organizers and services-related functions, as well as under-aged persons, shall not be allowed to follow the race. The Organization shall not be held liable in any way whatsoever for damages arising from accidents occurred prior, during or after the race to spectators and persons in general, even if unrelated to the race, depending from actions not attributable to that same Organization.

For all that is not regulated under the present regulation, the UCI, FCI, LCP regulations shall apply.

ARTICLE 16. Environment protection

The Organization commits itself to protecting the environment. In addition to providing “Green areas”, as per article 9, immediately after the passing of the race, the Organization will deploy appropriate staff to collect any objects or waste attributable to the race. Besides being actively engaged in protecting the environment, the Organization invites all the people involved in the event to behave respectfully towards the areas concerned.
